REPORTING REQUIREMENTS AND PROGRAM MEASURES**

**Reporting Requirements and Program Measures:** The MSPI projects submit a progress report every six months on the program measures related to their priority area and only on those measures relevant to their scope of work. The program measures are:

**6 Program Measures for the Methamphetamine and Suicide Prevention Initiatives**

1	The proportion of methamphetamine-using patients who enter a methamphetamine treatment program.
2	Reduce the incidence of suicidal activities (ideation, attempts) in AI/AN communities through prevention, training, surveillance, and intervention programs.
3	Reduce the incidence of methamphetamine abuse in AI/AN sites.
4	The proportion of youth who participate in evidence-based and/or promising practice (EBP/PP) prevention or intervention programs.
5	Establishment of crisis response teams.
6	Increase in telebehavioral health encounters.
