PREFACE

This manual provides information regarding the release and installation of the IHS ScriptPro Interface package. This package is for RPMS Outpatient Pharmacy 7.0.

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1.0 Release Notes

This package allows a site to interface with the ScriptPro dispensing system during the printing of a bottle label.

Functionality

The logic contained in the interface routine is accessed via the existing EXT INTERFACE HAS DRUG LOGIC and EXT INTERFACE CALL LOGIC fields in the APSP CONTROL file. The site can control which drugs are transmitted to the device by adding the drugs to the APSS DRUG file and entering a call to the check drug API in the EXT INTERFACE HAS DRUG LOGIC field. If the drug is valid, the logic in the EXT INTERFACE CALL LOGIC field is executed. This logic builds the information to be sent to the dispensing device using the APSS COMMAND file. The APSS COMMAND file is extensible meaning that additional supported ScriptPro fields can be included in the output stream without modifying the interface routine.

2.0 Installation Notes

Prefix: APSS

Current Version: 1.0

Warning: Read entire notes file prior to attempting any installation.

2.1 General Information

- Make a copy of this distribution for offline storage.
- Print all notes/readme files.
- It is recommended that the terminal output during the installation be captured using an auxport printer attached to the terminal at which you are performing the software installation. This will insure a printed audit trail if any problems should arise.

3.0 Installation Issues

3.1 File Access

Three FileMan files are delivered with this package.

APSS COMMAND (9009033.3)

APSS DRUG (9009033.2)

APSS PARAMETERS (9009033.1)

4.0 Installation Instructions

1. It is expected that prior to following these instructions for the production environment, that all sites will follow this process in their test environment first.
2. Get a copy of the installation file and copy it into a directory that is accessible from your M system.
3. Log into your production environment as a programmer at the MUMPS prompt and install package using KIDS installation utilities. It is recommended that the KIDS package be validated and compared to the current system before it is installed. See section 5.0 for sample installation.
4. Refer to the Technical Manual for instructions on editing the content of the EXT INTERFACE HAS DRUG and EXT INTERFACE CALL LOGIC fields in the APSP CONTROL file.

5.0 Sample Installation

The IHS ScriptPro Interface server software is a standard KIDS file that needs to be installed using the KIDS utilities, as demonstrated in the following screens:

1. Load KIDS Distribution.
 - a. Select Installation from the Kernel Installation & Distribution System.
 - b. Select Load a Distribution from the Installation Menu.
 - c. Type **apss0100.k** at Enter a Host File Prompt.
 - d. Type **YES** at the “Want to Continue with Load?” prompt.
2. Install KIDS Distribution.
 - a. Select Installation from the Kernel Installation & Distribution System
 - b. Select Install Package(s) from the Installation Menu.
 - c. Type **IHS SCRIPTPRO INTERFACE 1.0** at the “Install Name:” prompt.
 - d. Type **NO** at the “Want KIDS to Inhibit Logons During the Install?” prompt.
 - e. Type **NO** at the “Want to Disable Scheduled Options, Menu Options, and Protocols?” prompt.
 - f. Type the name of a print device where you want to print the install message at the “Device:” prompt.
