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1.0 Introduction

Please review these changes, and add a copy of them to any printed documentation your site may be using for Referred Care Information System Version 4.0. These changes will be integrated into future versions of the software and user manuals. These changes will no longer be considered an addendum at the time of the next version release.

This addendum only provides written guidance on changes made in the patch that are relevant to the user. To see a list of all changes made in a patch, please refer to the patch notes of each of the respective patches.

1.1 Summary of Changes

Patch 8 includes the following changes for both the RPMS RCIS application and the Referred-RCIS tabs located in the EHR Application.

1.1.1 ICD-10 Implementation

- All ICD Prompts have been changed to accept ICD9 and ICD10 codes based on DOS
- ICD DX Category updated with ICD-10 Categories and added Active and Inactive fields for the codes

1.1.2 Bug Fixes

- Fix for errors when modifying closed referrals
- Fix to allow selection of a closed referral when adding a secondary referral
- Fix for EHR SNOMED searching requiring programmer keys
- Changes to denial reason form and routine
- Changes to the ILOG, OLOG, and TLOG Reports to include approved referrals

2.0 Patch 9

2.1 Changes for ICD-10 Implementation

2.1.1 ICD Diagnostic Categories

When entering a new referral document, entering a new secondary referral or editing an existing referral document, the list of available ICD Diagnostic Categories will now include ICD-10 categories.

If the referral date of service or date entered is before the ICD-10 implementation date (i.e. 10/01/2015), the list will display ICD-9 categories.

If the referral date of service or date entered is after the ICD-10 implementation date (i.e. 10/01/2015), the list will display ICD-10 categories.

1. At the ICD Diagnostic Category field, type two question marks (??) and press Enter

3. Similarly in EHR-Referrals tabs, the dropdown list for IDC Diagnosis Categories will also update based on the referral date entered and the ICD-10 Implementation Date.

2.1.2 ICD DX Fields

When entering a new referral document, the Enter ICD DX prompt will now display a list of ICD-10 codes when the date of service or referral date entered is after the ICD-10 Implementation date (i.e. 10/01/2015).

Note: The **Stuff ICD/CPT Codes** site parameter must be set to NO in order to see the “Enter ICD DX” prompt when adding new referrals. If the parameter is set to YES, then it will use the appropriate uncoded code based on DOS or Referral date entered (i.e. ICD-9 uses .99999 and ICD-10 uses ZZZ.999).
