#### **Installation Instructions**

1. GENERAL INFORMATION

Listed below is a brief summary of enhancements included in this new Vs. 5.1 distribution:

- Package now includes Programmer/Developer Routines. The Technical Manual provides instruction to the Developer relative to Routine utilization of the automatic install of Taxonomies to associated Software packages.
- 2) BUL Enter Bulletin for a Taxonomy-This Menu Option has been modified to allow the User to do additional Mail Bulletin alert screenings for a specific taxonomy: (1) Send Bulletin 1st Visit Only, and (2) Send Bulletin by Visit Type; i.e., IHS, CONTRACT, etc.

  - 1. Save all ATX\* namespaced Routines

Restore Routines from file atx\_0510.r

Run Init D ^ATXINIT

CURRENT VERSION : 5.1 INSTALLATION VERSION : 5.1

This version of the Taxonomy Package provides the following enhancements:

- ⇒ The ability to choose when and if a bulletin will be sent. The developer can specify MUMPS code to be executed prior to the sending of a bulletin. If a 1 is returned, a bulletin will be sent, otherwise one will not be sent.
- ⇒ Package now includes Programmer/Developer Routines. The Technical Manual provides instructions to the developer relative to routine utilization of the automatic install of taxonomies to associated software packages (D^ATXSTX).
- ⇒ BUL Enter Bulletin for a Taxonomy- This menu option has been modified to allow the user to do additional Mail Bulletin alert screenings for a specific taxonomy: (1) Send Bulletin for 1st visit only, and (2) send bulletin by visit type; i.e., IHS, Contract, etc.

This version also provides a post-init that will clean up the existing surveillance taxonomies and clean up the 21st node of all existing taxonomies.
