Preface

The RPMS CHR/PCC Information and Reporting System (CHR/PCC) is used by Community Health Representatives (CHRs) to collect data about their activities. The CHR/PCC is a powerful tool. It permits CHRs to inform other members of the health-care team about health-related activities taking place in the patient's home or in the community.

Below is the main menu for the CHR/PCC Information and Reporting System. An individual user may have available one or more of these menu options.

1.0 About this Manual

This manual provides user instructions on installing Version 2.0 of the Community Health Representative Reporting System.

1.1 Key Changes in Version 2.0

- Data Entry Forms have been updated and redesigned.
- New Group Entry option using a pre-defined group definition.
- Display the following when a user logs into the CHR application:
 THIS SYSTEM CONTAINS CONFIDENTIAL PATIENT INFORMATION
 COVERED BY THE PRIVACY ACT. UNAUTHORIZED USE OF THIS DATA
 IS ILLEGAL
- Only last 4 digits of the SSN are now displayed on outputs.
- Created a file of Non-Registered patients.
- Created an option to merge duplicate Non-Registered Patients.
- Added canned or structured narratives to present to the user.
- Added an option to print or view a Patient Wellness Handout.
- Added the ability to Change Provider, Change Form and Change Date to the main data entry list manager form.
- Removed all references to CHRIS II
- Removed all references to the Remote data entry method.
- Referred to CHR by and Referred by CHR to are now multiple valued.
- Added 4 health problems codes:
- MH Men's Health
- DG Diagnostic Test
- DD Developmental Disabilities
- OS Osteoporosis
- Added new reports for unduplicated patient counts.
- Updated the CHR export record with new fields and version number.
- Added the ability to automatically send the export file to the National CHR Reporting System.

2.0 Installation Notes

2.2 Required Resources

- Kernel (XU) v8.0 or higher
- FileMan (DI) v22 or higher

2.3 Before You Begin: Installation Issues

- Make a copy of this distribution for offline storage
- Print all notes/readme files
- Create a printed audit trail, in case there are any problems with the installation

To capture terminal output during the installation, use an auxport printer attached to the terminal on which the installation is being performed.

3.0 Installation Instructions

Note: This installation is a KIDS install. For any questions on how to do a KIDS installation, please contact your Area Office information systems support personnel.

In all UCIs running the IHS CRS:

- 1. Ensure that users are unable to use the CHR Reporting System (main menu BCHMENU) for the duration of this installation
- 2. Save all routines (^%RO (CACHE) and globals (^%GO (CACHE) in the BCH* namespace for use in returning to the prior existing version, if needed.

Notes: If this is a first install, there will be no routines or globals in this namespace.

If no problems are noted with the new installation, remove saved routines from your system 7–10 days after this install.

- 3. Delete using ^%RDELETE all routines in the BCH*.* namespace. Many of the routines from version 1.0 are no longer in use.
- 4. Install bch_0200.k. This file is the KIDS file for the IHS RPMS CHR System.
 - a. Load the distribution into KIDS using **Option 1** on the **KIDS Installation** menu. The distribution was released in a file named bch_0200.k
 - b. Verify the load using **Option 2** on the **KIDS Installation** menu.
 - c. Consider using **Options 3** and **4** on the **KIDS Installation** menu to print and compare the Transport global.
 - d. For results, use the **KIDS Install File Print** option to view/print the IHS RPMS CHR SYSTEM V2.0 entry.

Note: For assistance with a KIDS install, call your Area Office support personnel.
