1.0 Introduction

This manual provides user instructions on installing Version 1.0 of the IHS CODE MAPPING utilities. These utilities provide mapping from IHS standard codes to SNOMED and LOINC codes. The mapping is done automatically when visits are created and when data elements are added to visits (V Files are created). It is also used by a variety of other applications. Version 1.0 provides code mapping to support the Meaningful Use Clinical Quality measures. Selected entries in the following IHS Standard code tables are supported in Version 1.0:

- EXAM
- HEALTH FACTORS
- PCC INFANT FEEDING CHOICES
- EDUCATION TOPICS
- PCC ADDITIONAL FEEDING CHOICES
- PATIENT STATUS CODE (NUBC)

- CLINICAL REVIEW ACTION
- SERVICE CATEGORY
- CPT

2.2 Before You Begin

- Make a copy of this distribution for offline storage
- Print all notes/readme files
- Create a printed audit trail, in case there are any problems with the installation

To capture terminal output during the installation, use an auxport printer attached to the terminal on which the installation is being performed.

3.0 Installation Instructions

Note: This installation is a KIDS install. For any questions on how to do a KIDS installation, please contact your Area Office information systems support personnel.

In all UCIs running IHS CODE MAPPING:

1. Save all routines (^%RO (CACHE) in the BCQM* namespace for use in returning to the prior existing version, if needed. If this is a first time install, there will be no routines in this namespace.

Notes:

- 1. *Do not* delete any of these routines prior to installation.
- 2. If no problems are noted with the new installation, remove saved routines from your system 7–10 days after this install.
- 2. Install bcqm0100.k. This file is the KIDS file for the IHS CODE MAPPING utilities.
 - a. Load the distribution into KIDS using **Option 1** on the **KIDS Installation menu**. The distribution was released in a file named bcqm0100.k
 - b. Verify the load using **Option 2** on the **KIDS Installation menu**.
 - c. Consider using **Options 3** and **4** on the **KIDS Installation menu** to print and compare the Transport global.
 - d. Install the distribution using option 6 on the Installation menu.
 - e. For results, use the **KIDS Install File Print** option to view/print the IHS CODE MAPPING entry.

Note: For assistance with a KIDS install, call your Area Office support personnel.
