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1.0 Introduction

Review these changes and add a copy of them to any printed documentation your site may be using for the Indian Health Service (IHS) Patient Care Component (PCC) Suite (BJPC) v2.0. These changes will be integrated into future versions of the software and user manuals. These changes will no longer be considered an addendum at the time of the next version release.

This addendum only provides written guidance on changes made in the patch that are relevant to the user. To see a list of all changes, please refer to the patch notes for each of the respective patches.

1.1 Summary of Changes

This patch contains changes to support the Social Security Number Fraud Prevention Act of 2017 and the Social Security Number Reduction Act.

SS# (Social Security Number) is removed from the following reports:

- VIS Listing of Billable Visits by Date
- DMG Detailed Patient Register
- PEF Print PCC Visit in Encounter Form Format
- GRP Group Preventive Form Entry
- RGF Reprint Group PCC Visit Forms
- COV Visits by Commissioned Officers and Dependents
- PGEN Patient General Retrieval
- VGEN Visit General retrieval
- QMAN Q-Man (PCC Query Utility

Other enhancements and fixes included in Patch 28 and not detailed below:

- Fixed issue where an error occurred when the DOD (Deceased Patients by Date of Death) report was queued to print.
- The QMAN query limit is increased to allow new query selection items to be added.
- Updated the LOG Menu label by removing Lab and APC references. These menu items were removed in Patch 27.

2.0 Patch 28 Inclusions

2.1 Tally of Reviewed/Completed Visits by You (TRVY) Report

This new report, added to the EHR/PCC Coding Audit Menu, allows the signed in user to view their own reviewed/completed visits. Statistics for other users cannot be viewed. The report is modeled after the Tally of Reviewed/Completed Visits by Operator (TRV).

The logged in user does not have to be the only user who reviewed the visit for it to be counted in the report.

Follow these steps:

- 1. At the "Enter Beginning REVIEW Date" prompt, type the beginning of the date range.
- 2. At the "Enter Ending REVIEW Date" prompt, type the end of the date range.
- 3. At the "Do you wish to see a subtotal by Review Date?" prompt, type Y or N.
- 4. At the "Device" prompt, type how you want the data to display.

You can do one of the following at the last prompt:

- Press ENTER to continue and to display the next page of information.
- Type caret (^) to exit the screen. You will be returned to the EHR/PCC Coding Audit menu.
