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1.0 Introduction

The changes detailed in this document are provided within Indian Health Service (IHS) Patient Care Component (PCC) Suite (BJPC) v2.0 p32. They will be integrated into future versions of the software and user manuals. These changes will no longer be considered an addendum at the time of the next version release.

This addendum provides written guidance only on changes made in the current patch that are relevant to the user. To see a list of all changes, please refer to the patch notes for each of the respective patches.

1.1 Summary of Changes

This patch contains enhancements to the Health Summary System and PCC Data Entry Mnemonics:

- Normal/Negative has been added as an allowable value for Exam (51) Pressure Injury Skin Exam, within the Examinations mnemonic.
- Continuous Glucose Monitoring (CGM) mnemonic has been added to capture Continuous Glucose Monitoring data.
- The CPT mnemonic has been updated to ensure that inactive CPT codes are not selectable.
- Continuity of Care Report: Error has been fixed when no data is returned.

Other enhancements included in p32 and not detailed in Section 2.0:

- Update field names in V HOSPITALIZATION file.
- Fields BIRTH ORDER and NEWBORN have been added to the V DELIVERY MULTIPLE file.

2.0 Patch 32 Changes

2.1 Mnemonics

2.1.1 Examinations (EX) Mnemonic

The Examinations (EX) mnemonic is used to record the type of exam performed during a patient visit (for visit-related-only encounters).

An additional allowable value, NORMAL/NEGATIVE, has been added to PRESSURE SKIN INJURY EXAM, to satisfy reporting needs. Mnemonics are used for quick entry of information into the Patient Care Component.

  ASQ- Suicide Screening and Pressure Injury Exam

N is a valid for all exam types, except VTE/Newborn Hearing/Suicide Assmt
PR, PAP, PA are only valid for Intimate Partner Violence exam type
A is not valid for Intimate Partner Violence/Alcohol Screening/Depression
Screening/VTE Risk Assessment/Suicide Risk Assessment/Newborn Hearing/
ASQ - Suicide Screening/SDOH or Unhealthy Drug Screen exam types
PO is valid for Depression Screening, Alcohol Screening, BIMS, SDOH,
Unhealthy Drug Screen and Pressure Injury exam types
L, M and H are valid for VTE Risk Assessment/Suicide Risk Assessment exams
and Pressure Injury Exam
PS (Pass) is only valid for Newborn Hearing Right and Left

2.1.2 Continuous Glucose Monitoring (CGM) Mnemonic

A new data entry mnemonic, CGM, has been created to capture Continuous Glucose Monitoring information.

The user is prompted to enter data in the following fields:

REPORT DATE:
REPORT PERIOD START DATE:
REPORT PERIOD END DATE:
DURATION (DAYS):
GMI - GLUCOSE MGMT INDICATOR %:
    Type a number between 2 and 20, 2 decimal digits.
TIME IN TARGET RANGE (TIR) %:
    Type a number between 0 and 100, 2 decimal digits.
TARGET RANGE LOW VALUE(mg/dL):
    Type a number between 60 and 150, 0 decimal digits.
TARGET RANGE HIGH VALUE(mg/dL):
    Type a number between 90 and 250, 0 decimal digits.

2.1.3 CPT Mnemonic update

The CPT mnemonic is used to record CPT codes for a visit (for visit-related-only encounters). The CPT mnemonic, CPT, has been updated to ensure that inactive CPT codes are not selectable.

2.2 Miscellaneous Report Changes

2.2.1 Continuity of Care (CC) Report: Error Fix

The continuity of care report measures the number of times that a patient saw their own designated primary care provider in a primary care clinic setting. This report now runs without error, even when no data is available.
