FIXES

Component	Fixes/Enhancements
Community Alerts	Synchronized with iCare
Exams	Stores correctly when provider other than logged in user is selected
Infusion orders	Drop down menus are corrected
Inpatient Meds for Outpatient	Infusions now display as “Clinic Orders” in IMO designated clinics
Inpatient orders	Start and stop times are corrected on complex orders
Menu options	New menu options added to BEH for Consults, Meds, Orders
Notifications	Fixed issue with lab notifications – was not moving from initial lab when processing multiple labs
Quick order wizard	Access violations fixed

Component	Fixes/Enhancements
Reminder Dialog	Skin Test Site and Volume prompts added
Reproductive History	Not longer displays dialog redundantly
Services	HCPCS search fixed, CPT narrative corrected
Skin Test	Date applied now populated when entering skin test
Visits	Inpatient ancillary lab and pharmacy visits are not displayed or selectable


Designated Provider
