1. GENERAL INFORMATION

a) Print all notes/readme files.

b) It is recommended that the terminal output during the installation is captured. This will insure a printed audit trail if any problems should arise.

c) changes included in this patch:

DSM-5 Coding

- Added all DSM-5 codes to the MHSS Problem/POV Codes file.
- Added a site parameter to allow a site to indicate what date they will stop coding in DSM-IV and begin coding in DSM-5.
- The POV tab in the GUI and visit screens in the roll and scroll have been redesigned to remove DSM-IV Multi-Axial Assessment and to accommodate DSM-5 coding.
- Modified the EHR to BH link to appropriately file a DSM-IV or DSM-5 code depending on the start date of DSM-5 coding.
- Updated the Treatment Plan to remove the DSM-IV Multi-Axial Assessment and to accommodate DSM-5 coding.
- Updated the case management screen to accommodate DSM-5 coding.
- Group Entry updated to accommodate DSM-5 coding.

CPT entry

- modified all modes of entry (GUI, R&S, Group) to allow the capture of multiple quantities and CPT modifiers

ICD-10 Coding

- Added ICD-10 codes to the MHSS Problem/POV codes file in preparation for ICD-10 coding which will begin in October 2014.
- Modified the BH to PCC Link to pass either ICD-9 or ICD-10 depending on the implementation date of ICD-10
- Modified reports, visits displays, etc to accommodate the 8 character ICD-10 diagnoses codes.

PCC Problem List updating has been disabled in the BH Module. To update the PCC Problem List users will need to use EHR.

Modified the export to add the coding system a POV code is associated with.

The non-administrative BH 2-digit problem codes have been inactivated and can no longer be selected.

3. REQUIREMENTS

- a) VA Kernel v 8.0 or later
- b) VA FileMan v 22.0 or later
- c) IHS Behavioral Health Version 4.0 through patch 3 (amh*4.0*3)

4. INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

In all UCIS running the IHS Behavioral Health System (AMH):

- 1) Save off all AMH* routines as a backup.
- 2) Load the Distribution into KIDS using option 1 on the KIDS Installation menu. The distribution was released in a file named amh_0400.04k.
- 3) Verify the load using option 2 on the KIDS Installation menu.
- 4) Consider using options 3 and 4 on the KIDS Installation menu to print and compare the Transport global.
- 5) Install the distribution using option 6 on the Installation menu.
- 6) For results, use the KIDS "Install File Print" option to view/print the "amh*4.0*4" entry.

 Instructions for installing the BHS 4.0 GUI:

On any PC where the Behavioral Health System client has been installed do the following:

1. Unzip amh_0400.04Client.zip into a directory of your choice on the client's PC.
 You will have 2 files: amh_0400.04.msi and amh_0400.04setup.exe
2. Double Click amh_0400.04setup.exe that was distributed with the Behavioral Health System client.
3. Follow the prompts on the Behavioral Health Setup Screens, taking the defaults.
