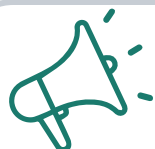


# Community Opioid Intervention Prevention Program

Semi-Annual Report (February-August, 2025)



## Increase Public Awareness & Education

- 39 traditional activities implemented, including Pow Wows, blanket weaving, & storytelling.
- 3,360 education and awareness activities implemented across programs.
- 5 opioid related conferences completed this reporting period.



## Support Teams & Family Empowerment

- Comprehensive supports were developed to strengthen families and community response.
- Expanded teams with more Peer Support Specialists focused on risk management with people who use substances.



## Reduce Unmet Needs & Opioid Deaths Via MOUD

- Medication for Opioid Use Disorder (MOUD) expanded to reduce unmet needs and overdose deaths.
- 27 participants began MOUD & successfully transitioned to sober living programs.



## Implement Risk Management

- 36 risk management activities implemented, including increasing Narcan access, medication lock boxes, & distributing fentanyl test strips.
- Modoc Nation collaborated with their local casino to place a Narcan distributing machine in a casino bar lounge.



## Cross-Cutting Accomplishments

## Challenges

- Grantees face challenges in building staffing capacity due to their rural locations and the limited number of qualified applicants.
- These challenges are addressed by training staff within the organization, expanding recruitment efforts, & strengthening partnerships.
