- 1/ FY 2020 figures are not yet final due to an indefinite appropriation and an appropriation account available for obligation through September 30, 2021. Amounts reflect the FY 2020 enacted budget with permissable reprogrammings through September 30, 2020.
- 2/ Reflects the transfer of section 105(/) lease costs in FY 2021 to the new indefinite appropriation account, Payments for Tribal Leases. Funds for village built clinics remain within the Hospitals and Health Clinics budget line.
- 3/ Funding increases from previously enacted budgets continue to be used for the same purposes and remain within the applicable appropriation account and budget line, but are no longer specified by amount in the FY 2021 explanatory statement and/or remain consistent with House Report 116-448.
- 4/ Includes a program increase of \$5 million above the FY 2020 operating level for Tribal Epidemiology Centers.
- 5/ Includes a program increase of \$1 million above the FY 2020 operating level for domestic violence prevention.
- 6/ Includes \$2 million for the existing Tribal dental health therapist training program that trains students in Alaska, Washington, Idaho, and Oregon.
- 7/ Includes an additional \$500,000 above the FY 2020 operating level for the electronic dental health record system to finish bringing dental centers onto the system and to manage the current electronic dental record system.
- 8/ Includes an additional \$1 million above the FY 2020 operating level to increase the number of Dental Support Centers.
- 9/ Includes a program increase of \$500,000 above the FY 2020 operating level for essential detoxification services.
- 10/ Funding for the former National Institute on Alcohol Abuse and Alcoholism Programs as provided in FY 2020 is continued in FY 2021 at the same level.
- 11/ Includes a loan repayment program increase of \$1 million above the FY 2020 operating level, with a spending cap of \$41 million in total.
- 12/ Includes an additional \$1 million above the FY 2020 operating level for the scholarship program.

- 14/ The Further Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2020, Public Law 116-94, dated December 20, 2019, provided a total of \$96,575,342 for the Special Diabetes Program for Indians through May 22, 2020. The Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act), Public Law 116-136, dated March 27, 2020, provided the full funding level of \$150 million for FY 2020, and \$25,068,493 for the period beginning on October 1, 2020, and ending on November 30, 2020. The Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021, Public Law 116-260, dated December 27, 2020, provided the full funding level of \$150 million for FY 2021.
