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IHS HIM Program

- October 2012 HIM Program went under Office of Information Technology
 - Provide assistance and guidance to I/T/U facilities and individuals – medical legal advise
 - Develop/Update Policy and Procedures
 - HIM Chapter 3
 - HIPAA
 - EHR for HIM and MU
 - Interacts with all levels of the organization to ensure a high quality and legally sound health record program.

HIM Program

- Consultant - Oversight of Area HIM Program
 - Site Reviews
 - Coding Audits
 - EHR support and implementation
 - Many are ICD-10 Coordinators, MU Coordinators and Vista Imaging Coordinators
- HIPAA Privacy Officer/Privacy Act Liaison/FOIA
 - Investigation and Reporting to HQ & Incident Response Team (IRT)
 - Collaborate with IHS Privacy Official

HIM Activities

- Subject matter experts in RPMS EHR development
- Communication of new initiative and applications
 - Conduct annual EHR and MU for HIM training
- HIPAA Omnibus Update publish January 25, 2013 for enforcement September 23, 2013 – new patient rights
 - Revising Indian Health Manual – Part II, Chapter 7 with the Privacy Officer and Office of General Counsel
- ICD-10 Initiative
 - Many ICD-10 Coordinators are HIM Consultants
 - 236 sites hosted training from May 2012 – July 2013
 - Process of developing clinical modules
 - Driving the initiative – ICD-10 Insider newsletter, ListServ, etc.
- Monthly call and meet semi-annually
- Policy and Procedures for Meaningful Use Data Sharing

HIM Future Focus

- Electronic data transfer - exchange:
 - Secure email system to support the EHR and PHR
 - Patients will have the option to communicate with their providers via the PHR
 - Visit Creation may be necessary – On-Line Service Clinic Code
 - Providers will be able to receive electronic documents to be filed and stored
 - Providers will be able to send electronic transfer of care documents
 - HIM will play a key role in these new work flow processes and ensuring patient PHI protection.
