would arise from the flooding, in order of urgency. I also helped out with discovering illegal

dump sites around the reservation this summer. Once the sites were found, we took steps to make sure that these areas were cleaned up properly, and made signs to prevent additional dumping.

My summer also consisted of putting together an environmental health fair, where the public could gain information on a variety of environmental issues such as pest control, and the importance of hand washing. We also provided a Food Handler's training where information on Foodborne illnesses was made accessible to the general public. This summer I also



helped out with a few food inspections, a seatbelt survey, and a couple of water samples as well.
