What is the DVPI Portal?

- The DVPI Portal is an online reporting system where DVPI funded projects submit their Annual Progress Report (APR) and other documents.
- The portal is located on the DVPI Webpage

What is the purpose of the DVPI Portal?

- DVPI projects report on their yearly activities according to their scope of work and Purpose Area.
- The APR opens on **October 1** and the reports are due on **October 31**.
- **Reporting Period:**
 - September 30, 2017-September 29, 2018
 - September 30, 2018-September 29, 2019
 - September 30, 2019-September 29, 2020

What goes into the DVPI Portal?

- If you are identified as a **federal awardee**, you are required to complete your APR via the portal and upload documents in the DVPI Portal.
- If you are a **grantee**, you are required to submit a copy of the APR in GrantSolutions.

*The APR is completed via the DVPI portal and you cannot submit the APR using a Word document.

- Authorized Project Official(s) are responsible for completing the **annual progress report via the portal.**
 - Program Coordinator
 - Project Director

How do you login to the DVPI Portal?

- Step 1: Go to the DVPI [webpage](#).
- Step 2: Select the **DVPI Portal** on the left tab.
- Step 3: Click on the **DVPI Portal** on the right.
- Step 4: Select **Login** at the top right.





Recovering a Password, cont'd

- Step 7: You will receive the following email message that has instructions on how to reset your password.

- Step 2: Click on **Continue.**
- Step 3 : Fill out the populated form and the request will be sent to the area office for approval.
- Step 4: Click on **Continue** again.


