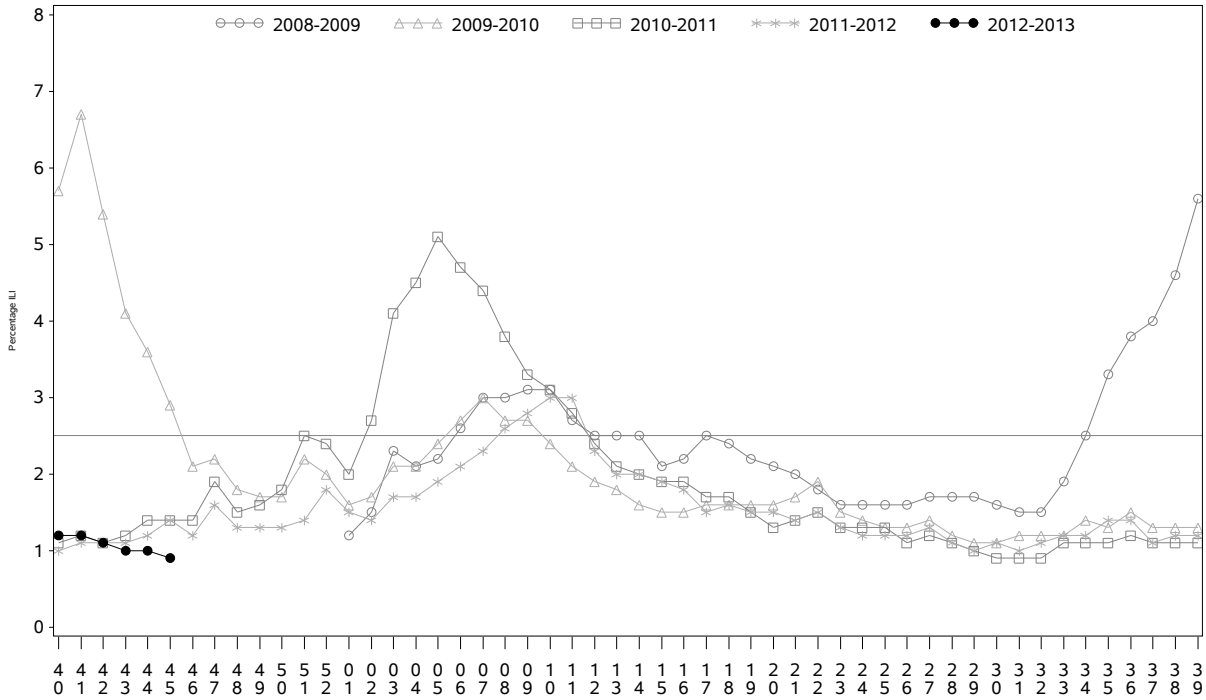


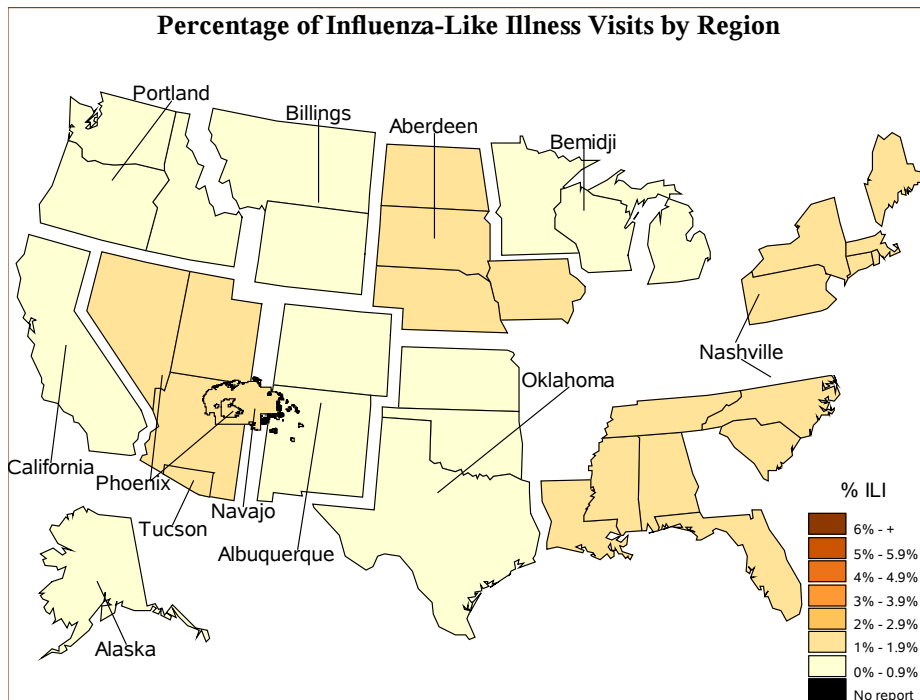

 The baseline is the mean percentage of ILI patient visits during non-influenza weeks for the previous two seasons plus two standard deviations.



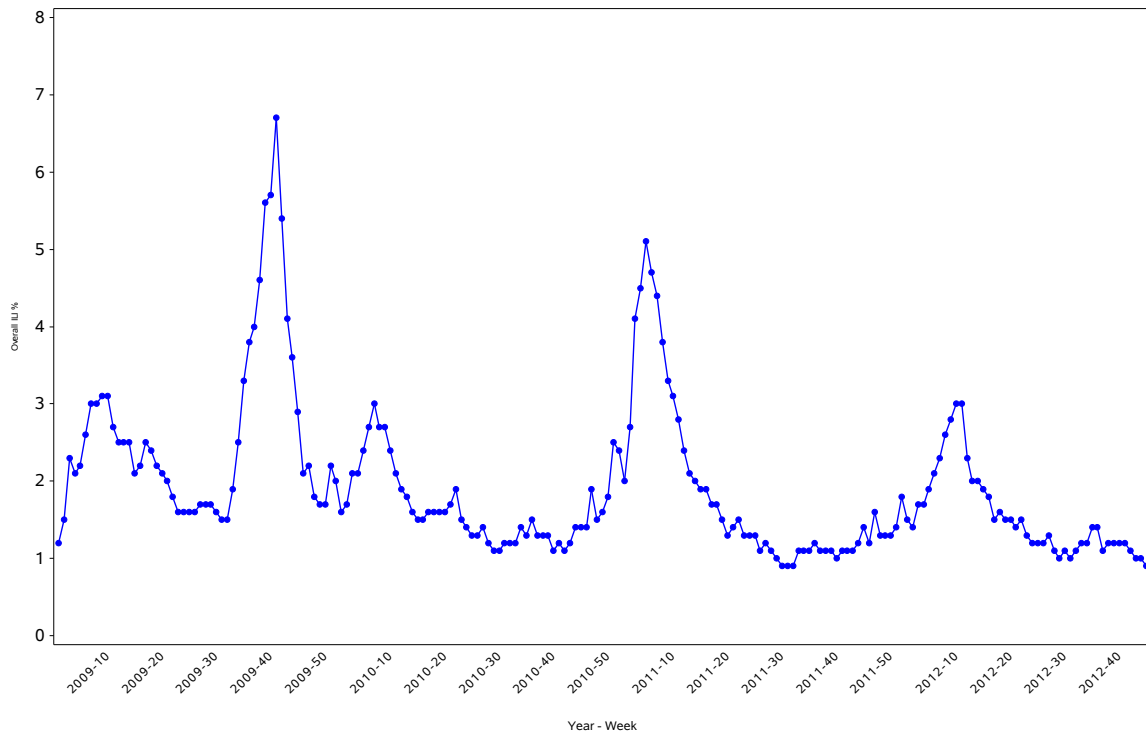

01/04/09 to 11/10/12

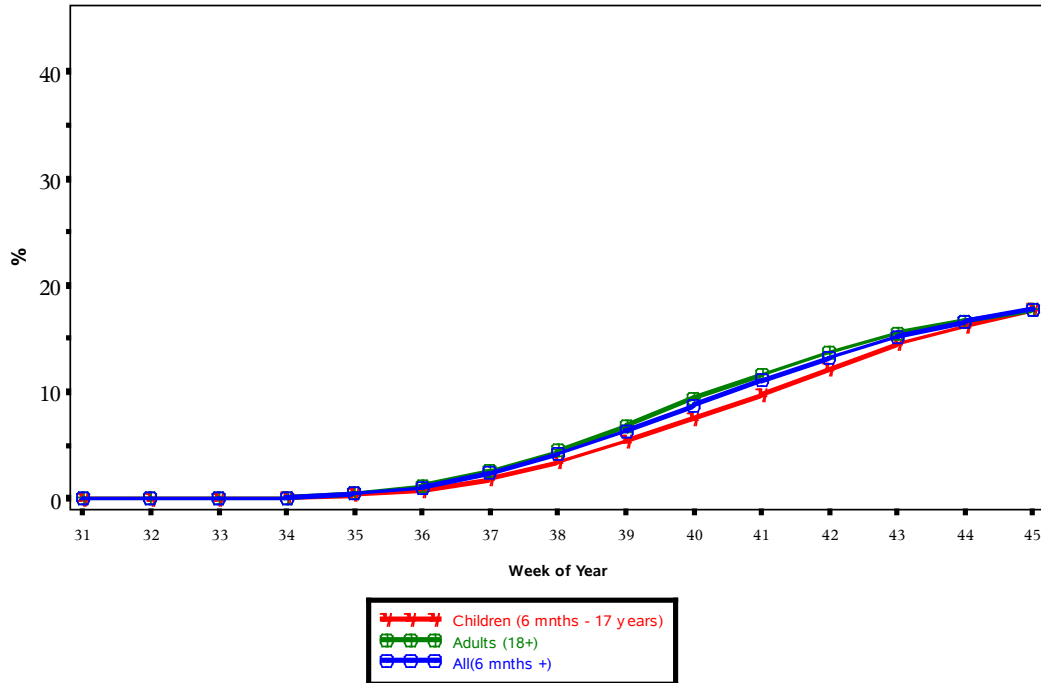


Percentage of ILI visits is number of ILI visits divided by total number of daily visits.

IHS Influenza Vaccination Surveillance

- As of 11/10/2012, sites reporting to the IIAS have administered 234,221 doses (1st and 2nd) of seasonal influenza vaccine to Active Clinical*patients.
