Build capacity to address injuries and violence for American Indian and Alaska Native people through community-driven, culturally centered approaches

Key dates	Application deadline: November 13, 2025 Award date: January 1, 2026
Key Information	TIPCAP recipients will be funded per year for 5 years. Eligible applicants will only be issued one award, either for Part I or Part II. • Part I: Up to \$150,000 per year (~ 15 awards) • Part II: Up to \$40,000 per year (~ 12 awards)
Who can apply?	Federally recognized American Indian or Alaska Native Tribes, Tribal organizations, and Urban Indian organizations. Part I recipients must have a 2,500 minimum IHS user population. O Part I recipients are funded to hire a full-time injury prevention coordinator to develop an injury prevention program. O Part II recipients are funded to develop injury prevention projects.
