Step 1 - Exclusion: If no exclusion is available =N/A. If there is an exclusion available, does the EP meet exclusion criteria? =Yes/No.

Step 2 - Current Period: If Current Period exceeds Stage 1 Target; EP meets MU for that measure.

Step 3- Attestation: If attestation measure=Yes/No. If measure requires a rate=N/A.

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Step 1 – Exclusion: The Exclusion column displays a Yes or No if an exclusion is available for a rate measure that requires a numerator and denominator. If an exclusion is not available for any measure, then N/A displays in that column. If the EP meets the exclusion requirements for that core or menu set performance measure, then the report summary will display a Yes in that column. A No will display in that column if the EP does not meet exclusion requirements for that measure. If an EP meets the exclusion criteria for one or more measures, then they may use that excluded measure as one of the measures required for meeting meaningful use. The excluded measure does not have to be replaced by another measure. The EP must attest to CMS whether or not they meet these exclusion requirements. Step 2 – Current Period: When the rate in the Current Period column is greater than the rate in the Stage 1 Target column, the EP meets meaningful use for that measure. The only exception would be the Timely Electronic Access menu set measure, where the rate in the Current Period column can be greater than *or* equal to the rate in the Stage 1 Target column. If the EP meets exclusion requirements for any measure, the rate in the Current Period column does not have to be greater than or equal to the rate in the Stage 1 Target column, as the EP is excluded from having to meet meaningful use for that measure.

Step 3 – Attestation: The Attestation column displays a Yes or No. N/A will display in this column if a measure is a rate measure with a numerator and denominator or if the EP chooses not to include that menu set performance measure as one of the 5 (out of 10) for that reporting period. Yes/No attestation measures will display N/A in the numerator, denominator, current period, and previous period columns on the report summary. The Yes or No response can be either system generated, or user defined in response to the attestation measure questions asked when running the Performance Measure Report in the RPMS Roll and Scroll.

- EPs must meet all [15 Core Set Performance Measures](#) and at least [5 of the 10 Menu Set Performance Measures, including at least one public health measure](#).
- The denominator represents the whole, and the numerator represents part of the whole. Both numbers are used to calculate the rate in the Current Period column. Numerator / Denominator = Rate.
- If the user chooses not to include previous period data when running the Performance Measure report, this column will display 0.0% for all measures that require a numerator and denominator.
- Performance Measure Report Summaries for EPs and EHs/CAHs are formatted the same way.
- Upon running the Performance Measure Report, responses are system generated for the following core performance measures: CPOE Medication, e-Prescribing (eRx), and Drug Interaction Checks, as well as the menu performance measure Drug-Formulary Checks, as RPMS EHR automatically calculates the rate (Numerator/Denominator = Current Period) or automatically answers Yes or No in the Attestation column on the Performance Measure Report Summary.
- If the EP does not meet meaningful use on a performance measure, further evaluation may be needed as to why, and additional actions may be necessary in order for the EP to meet all CMS EHR Incentive Program requirements.
