As an active NHSC site, your facility will receive the following benefits:

- The ability to recruit qualified NHSC scholars and providers participating in the Loan Repayment Program.
 - NHSC providers include primary care physicians (MD or DO), physician assistants, nurse practitioners, certified nurse-midwives, psychiatrists, dentists, dental hygienists, psychologists, licensed clinical social workers, psychiatric nurse specialists, marriage and family therapists, and licensed professional counselors.
- Access to the NHSC Job Opportunities List where you can post primary care provider vacancies and receive news about NHSC job placement events.
- Educational, training and networking resources that support your facility and your NHSC providers.

This year's NHSC Loan Repayment Application cycle closes on May 26, 2011. If your site is interested in recruiting providers or if you have eligible providers who may be interested in loan repayment, please follow the instructions below:

- **Complete a Site Profile.** The NHSC Site Profiles provide NHSC clinicians with information about your facility and the surrounding community. The site profile form can be found at http://www.nhsc.hrsa.gov/communities/siteprofileform.pdf.
- **Post Job Openings at Your Site.** Post any job openings you may have on the NHSC Job Opportunities List, which is reviewed regularly by current and prospective NHSC providers. Call 1-877-313-1823 to speak with a representative who can post new and update current vacancies.
