I am writing to share the Indian Health Service (IHS) Fiscal Year (FY) 2023 Budget to Support Urban Indian Organizations (FY 2023 Budget Report).

The purpose of the FY 2023 Budget Report is to provide financial transparency and accountability for the Urban Indian Health Budget line. This aligns with the IHS Office of Urban Indian Health Programs (OUIHP) 2023-2027 Strategic Plan recommendations to increase transparency of funds allocated to Urban Indian Health Programs.¹

In support of the strategic plan goals, the FY 2023 Budget Report details the funds distribution by the OUIHP and IHS Area Offices.
