Dear Arizona Tribal Leader:

I am writing to initiate Tribal Consultation and seek your recommendations on an updated feasibility study for creating a state-wide Purchased/Referred Care Delivery Area (PRCDA) in Arizona.

As noted in the June 23, 2025, letter, the Indian Health Service (IHS) previously completed a feasibility study to designate the State of Arizona as a PRCDA for the purpose of providing Purchased/Referred Care (PRC) services to members of Indian Tribes in the State of Arizona. However, that feasibility study is now outdated due to changes in Tribal enrollment numbers, demographics, and funding that have occurred since its development.

The IHS is re-evaluating whether a state-wide PRCDA in Arizona remains feasible, appropriate, and beneficial for Tribes. We are seeking your input on the potential impact of a state-wide PRCDA on PRC program funds and on the ability to purchase comprehensive health care services for Indians throughout the State of Arizona.
