Dear Tribal Leader and Urban Indian Organization Leader:

On November 13, 2025, the Indian Health Service (IHS) initiated a second round of Tribal Consultation and Urban Confer to seek your input on the next phase of the Agency's proposed realignment. On December 5, 2025, in response to feedback, the IHS expanded the Tribal Consultation schedule to add four additional sessions, including a virtual Consultation for a total of nine meetings, ending with the virtual Urban Confer on January 15, 2026.

I am writing to share that in response to verbal feedback during Consultations and written comments received regarding the timeline for the proposed realignment, I am extending the comment submission deadline for this Tribal Consultation and Urban Confer until **February 27, 2026**.
