Contract Support Costs Proposal in the FY 2016 President's Budget



- There is a need for a long-term solution for CSC appropriations developed with Tribal recommendations
- The goal is to fund CSC fully. The FY 2016 Budget Request includes:
 - A \$55 million increase for IHS total \$718 million
 - A \$26 million increase for BIA total \$277 million



Contract Support Costs Proposal in the FY 2016 President's Budget



- The Budget Request also includes a proposal to:
 - Shift CSC to a three-year mandatory appropriation in FY 2017 (This would be separate from discretionary funding, the rest of the budget)
 - Goal to fully fund CSC
 - Allow no-year funds to carry over into the next fiscal year
 - Update funding levels with reauthorization
- This allows for:
 - Tribal Consultation on this proposal
 - Time for Congress to plan



Contract Support Costs Proposal in the FY 2016 President's Budget



Estimated annual funding levels to fund CSC fully:

	FY 2017	FY 2018	FY 2019
IHS	\$800	\$925	\$1,100
BIA	\$307	\$322	\$338

Of these amounts, up to 2% can be used for program administration
