Rear Adm. Michael D. Weahkee Statement on the Sentencing of Former IHS Pediatrician Stanley Patrick Weber

The Indian Health Service appreciates that justice has been delivered today. With the longawaited sentencing of a former IHS pediatrician, Stanley Weber, I hope that those who were harmed by him can find some measure of comfort. The actions of this individual were reprehensible, and we sincerely regret the harm caused to the children involved.

The Indian Health Service is <u>committed to ensuring a culture of quality, leadership and</u> <u>accountability</u>. We prioritize a workforce that is dedicated and trustworthy. Protecting our patients is a key element of delivering quality care. The IHS is committed to <u>protecting our</u> <u>patients</u> and preventing their harm to the best of our ability.
