That's right, the Cybersecurity Operations Center knows how to deal with phishing, ransomware, and hackers so you don't have to. **And using CSOC is EASY.** Just take that phishing email or any other cyber incident you come across and forward it to... INCIDENT@ihs.gov. And if that's too many letters to type, just click the REPORT PHISHING button on your Outlook ribbon!

CSOC also has a new phone number that is staffed 24 x 7: 866-347-2762 (866-DIS-CSOC)!

I know it seems too easy, but it really is **JUST THAT SIMPLE.** Forwarding to Incident@ihs.gov, clicking Report Phishing, or calling 866-DIS-CSOC allows the CSOC team to stay on top of new threats at IHS and keeps the entire agency **CYBER-BEAUTIFUL!**

- Keep your desk clean of sensitive information!
- When not directly connected to the IHS network, use the IHS virtual private network (VPN) for IHS business!
