Recommended SNOMED/ICD and CPT codes for Chronic Opioid Therapy

Identifying Patients on Chronic Opioid Therapy:

Add an entry to the IPL:

- Long-term current use of opiate analgesic drug
- SNOMED = **452271000124108**

Tip – searching for this code can be challenging. Your local informaticist can place it on a pick list for easier access.

It likely won't come up on your first attempt from the IPL when using the Add button, even if you type the full name in the search box when adding a new entry to the IPL:

Functional Status Assessment

To document function status assessment as structured data in RPMS EHR, use a CPT code.

You may use any validated function status assessment that is appropriate for your patient. Be aware that some assessments are copyrighted. Some examples are Pain Disability Index, Physical Function Ability Questionnaire FAQ5, and DVPRS – Defense and Veterans Pain Rating Scale.

The appropriate CPT code is:

CPT 1502F: Patient queried about pain and pain interference with function using a valid and reliable instrument

This can also be added to a Superbill by your local informaticist.
