

LOCKING PRESCRIPTION BOTTLE

PROCUREMENT RESOURCES

LOCKING PRESCRIPTION BOTTLES ARE AVAILABLE THROUGH A VARIETY OF SOURCES INCLUDING PHARMACY VENDORS, LIKE MCKESSON.

For a limited time they will be available through the *Indian Health Service National Supply Service Center (NSSC)*.

Submit through your regular NSSC channels or point of contact.
The items will be shipped to your regular NSSC shipping address.

HOW MUCH WILL LOCKING PRESCRIPTION BOTTLES COST THROUGH NSSC?

For the initial pilot period, facilities or programs submitting orders will not be charged.

- *In order to receive this benefit, orders must not exceed a maximum of 50 bottles (or one case per order per site).*

The cost of a locking prescription bottle via pharmacy vendors is around \$5-\$15 per bottle, depending on size and quantity.

WHO SHOULD CONSIDER USING A LOCKING PRESCRIPTION BOTTLE?

- Households with children or vulnerable individuals.
- Individuals taking controlled substances.
- Caregivers responsible for another person's medications.
- Households with visitors or multiple generations within the home.

HOW DO PHARMACY OR COMMUNITY STAFF PREPARE TO DEPLOY THESE TOOLS?

*Read and familiarize yourself with the package instructions in order to educate others.
Discuss the benefits of these products with patients and community members.*
