# Provider Prescription Drug Monitoring Program Documentation

Per IHS Chapter 32, (<u>https://www.ihs.gov/ihm/pc/part-3/p3c32/</u>) prescribers and pharmacists shall access the appropriate state PDMP at specified times throughout the course of caring for a patient receiving a controlled substance prescription.

It is recommended to document PDMP monitoring through the use of a patient education code. With this method, the patient will need to be provided with education following these proposed standards:

## **Proposed** Education Outcomes/Standards for PDMP education

OUTCOME: The patient/family will understand the findings of the state-based Prescription Drug Monitoring Program and the potential risks (if any) suggested from these findings.

#### STANDARDS:

**Explain PDMP results** 

- 1. Meaning of PDMP results
- 2. Follow-up tests that may be ordered based on the results
- 3. How the findings may impact or effect the treatment plan
- 4. Recommendations based on the PDMP findings
- 5. Refer to community resources or specialty care if appropriate

#### The PDMP education code can be accessed through a variety of methods, described below.

#### Documenting PDMP check in the IPL:

Select a patient and a visit (must have a visit selected in order to set a problem as a POV)


Choose the appropriate IPL entry (or add an appropriate entry) upon which to document the PDMP controlled substance check. Use the diagnosis on the problem list for which the patient is receiving opioids.

There are two (2) ways to mark a problem for use as a POV

#### Option #1: Marking a problem as a POV:

If you are adding the problem for the first time, or if you select the problem from the IPL and then click on the **Edit** button, you will see this dialog box:



When you click on the **Use as POV** box, it will make **the Add Visit Instructions/Care Plans/Goal Activities** button available for use. Click it.

From this box, you can document the PDMP check via Patient Education\*


### Documenting PMDP Education via the Education Component of EHR
