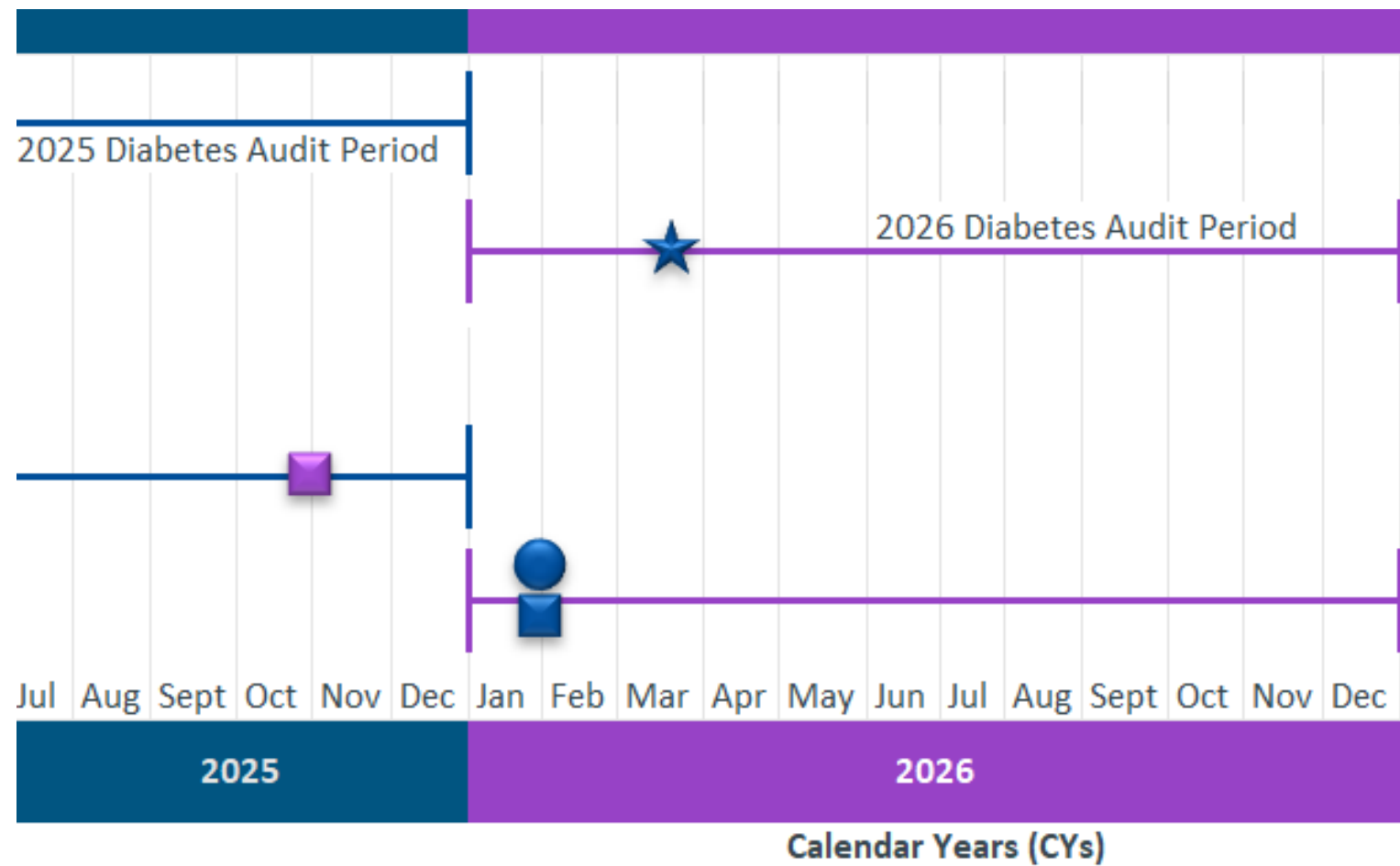

## 2025 Timeline



-  October 31, 2025 - 2026 Non-Competing Continuation Application due in GrantSolutions (GS)
-  January 30, 2026 - 2025 Required Key Measure (RKM) Final data submitted in the SDPI Outcomes System (SOS)
-  January 30, 2026 - 2025 Annual Progress Report due in GS PPR
-  March 20, 2026 - 2026 Diabetes Audit Data due (collect data on CY 2025)



# SDPI Outcomes System (SOS)



# Report: SOS Final Data

- **What?**

- Best Practice Required Key Measure (RKM) data captured at the end of the year to see if data improved.
  - Avoid aggregate for final data (or will need waiver).
  - Time of the year to “lock” your data.

- **Why?**

- Data reporting requirement.

- **How?**

- local records → SOS

OR

- RPMS/EMR → WebAudit → SOS



# SOS Requirement

- The SOS is a web-based data system for SDPI programs to enter, check, and download RKM data for their Target Group for their selected [Diabetes Best Practice](#).
- This report must include the following:
  - Your program's selected Best Practice.
  - Target Group number.
  - Target Group description.
  - RKM baseline data for 2025.
  - RKM final data for 2025.





## Report: SOS Final Data (cont'd)

- **Where?**

- **Who?**
  - Division of Diabetes (SDPI Team): [sdpi@ihs.gov](mailto:sdpi@ihs.gov)
  - Area Diabetes Consultant: <https://www.ihs.gov/diabetes/about-us/area-diabetes-consultants-adc/>
- **When?**
  - Annually, due by end of January of the next year.
  - Covers data from the previous year.



# Annual Progress Report



# Report: Annual Progress Report

- **What?**

- Report providing updates summarizing your program's grant year.
- Review of your program plan (project narrative) – have all activities/services been implemented and budget been spent?
- Submission of final data for the year (from SOS).

- **Why?**

- Reporting requirement by DGM and DDTP.

- **How?**

- Complete/gather your 2025 SOS RKM Data Summary Report.
- Complete template (or equivalent) provided on the SDPI Report/Application webpage.
- Submit reports above under the **Performance Progress Report**.

# 2025 Annual Progress Report Template

The template is provided as an option for submitting the required information. Alternatively, all required information from the template can be provided on a separate document.

Tips for using template to prepare a successful (and complete) Annual Progress Report:

- Download (Save) a copy of the template to your computer.
- Ensure that all contributors are opening the template in Adobe Reader or Pro software to complete.
- Save the completed document – do not print and/or scan.
- Proofread to ensure all fields are completed and to minimize grammatical/spelling errors.

  - Annually, due by end of **January**.
  - Covers activities/outcomes from the previous year.



# Performance Progress Report (PPR)



## Report: PPR

- **What?**
  - Feature that collects Recipient Progress Reports in a single, trackable location.
- **Why?**
  - Recipients can upload their progress reports, easily track, and manage due dates.
- **How?**
  - Access the PPR in GrantSolutions, under the “Reports” tab.

# Annual Progress Report Submission - PPR



## Submission Steps:

1. Log into [GrantSolutions](#).
2. Look for your SDPI grant. Click on the arrow or grant number to access "Grant Details" screen.
3. Click on the Reports tab.
4. Use the *Report Type* drop-down to find and start your **Annual PPR with 01/01/2025 – 12/31/2025** Reporting Period.
5. Click on the Start Report button.
6. Follow the guidance provided in the PPR to upload report requirements and submit the report.
7. Notify your [Area Diabetes Consultant](#) that the report has been submitted in GrantSolutions.



# Tips for Successful 2025 PPR Submission for SDPI



1. Look to start the report with the Reporting Period of **01/01/2025 – 12/31/2025**
  - a) This may be under the “Past Reporting Periods”.
2. If last year’s report was already submitted (e.g., 2024 submitted under the 2025 report), reach out to your [Area Diabetes Consultant](#). They may be able to send the report back to you so you can edit or delete and start over.
3. Scroll down to “Report on your performance” – this is where the report can be uploaded.
4. At minimum, your report should include:
  - a) Completed 2025 Annual Report template (or document responding to questions from the template)
  - b) 2025 SOS RKM Data Summary Report with Baseline and Final Data.
5. Keep scrolling to “Finish and submit”.
6. Watch emails for any updates; including reports that may be returned.
  - a) Or can revisit the Reports tab to check on status updates.
