RETHINK YOUR LAWN

Billions of gallons of water are used every day to water grass lawns and gardens¹.

- Use native plants, which do not require fertilizer and require fewer pesticides
- Consider saving water in drier landscapes by xeriscaping, a form of landscaping that reduces or eliminates the need for irrigation
