UDS Summary Report Final – Calendar Year 2017

The Resource and Patient Management System Uniform Data System (UDS) provides a “snapshot” of program performance for the reporting calendar year. Data includes basic demographic information on the populations served and types and quantities of services provided. The following Tables indicate key findings of the 2017 UDS for the entire Urban Indian Organization (UIO) population served as well as for each of the three program types. In addition, key trends are addressed. Note: The UDS summaries report Universal data (all patients) and American Indian and Alaska Native (AI/AN) patients only. Indian Health Service (IHS) funding is not used for non-AI/AN patients/services. An agency may receive funding from sources other than IHS which support the non-AI/AN population as well as the AI/AN population.

The data from 35 UIOs are included in the UDS Summary Report for calendar year 2017. The IHS Office of Urban Indian Health Programs funds four types of programs: Outreach and Referral, Limited Ambulatory, Full Ambulatory, and Outpatient and Residential Substance Abuse Treatment Programs. These four program types differ in terms of their service delivery model, staffing, and program expectations. It should be noted that six UIOs are categorized as Outpatient and Residential Substance Abuse Treatment Programs and do not report. Therefore, they are not included in the UDS report.

Table 1 reports the total number of community members served by the Urban Indian Health Programs (UIHPs) and the percentage who are American Indian or Alaska Native (AI/AN).
