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Why Target HCPS?

Multiple studies demonstrate that higher vaccination rates of HCPs have been associated with lower incidence of nosocomial influenza, influenza-like illness and mortality during influenza season.

Influenza Transmission in Health-Care Settings

- HCPs are exposed to patients with influenza at work
- HCPs transmit influenza virus to patients and coworkers


