Description:

In September 2023 the COVID-19 vaccine will transition to a traditional public/private model like all other routine vaccines. The Indian Health Service Vaccine Task Force (VTF) will provide a final update regarding COVID-19 vaccines that are authorized or approved by the Food and Drug Administration and endorsed by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. This webinar will inform healthcare team members at all levels about the updated COVID-19 vaccine formulation, new products, presentations, dosing, and clinical guidance about the updated COVID-19 vaccines.

Outcomes/Objectives:

1. Summarize clinical recommendations for the Fall 2023 respiratory virus season, including seasonal influenza, 2023 COVID-19 monovalent vaccine, and Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) vaccines.
2. Discuss procurement and access to COVID-19 vaccines via private acquisition and public programs.
3. Describe the authorized dosing schedule, storage, handling, and administration recommendations for the commercialized COVID-19 vaccines authorized or approved for use in the U.S.
4. Review fall 2023 respiratory vaccine implementation strategies, including influenza, RSV vaccines and COVID-19 vaccine co-administration.

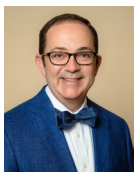

Dr. Clark serves as the IHS Ex-Officio Member of the CDC's Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP) and as the Operations Team Lead for the IHS National E3 Vaccine Strategy.
