This webinar will focus on developing the skills of providers and families of children with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) in identifying basic principles of Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA), differentiating types of ABA intervention through case examples, examine misconceptions regarding ABA and how to utilize ABA strategies with children with autism.
